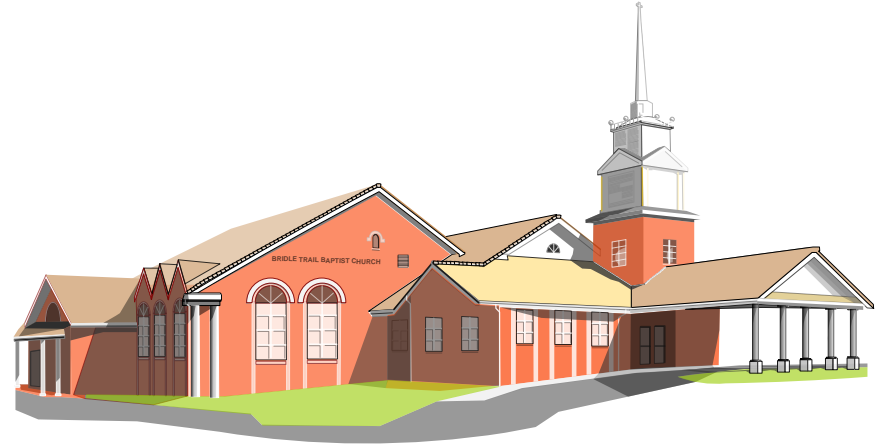

Revised Schedule for the Ordination of Pastors (BTBC 2021-2022)

Please pray for our candidate for ordination: Pastor Wayne Huen as we affirm his calling from God as Pastors.

May 23 (Sun)	To post the names of candidates for ordination and the schedule of ordination to the congregations for the request of prayers	
Jun. 20 (Sun)	Deadline for church members to propose the nomination of candidate in writing.	Note 1
Jul 10 (Sat)	Deacon Board meeting to finalize names of candidates for ordination	Note 2
Jun. 21 to Jul. 25	Ordination Committee to examine all of the recommendations from both the Board of Deacons and church members	
Sep. 20 to Sep. 30	Candidates for ordination will be interviewed by CBOQ Credentials Committee	Note 3
Oct. 24 (Sun)	To approve the final list of candidates for ordination and post their personal information for public notice	
Nov.2 (Tue)	Candidates for ordination will be interviewed internally by the Ordination Examination Council with designated Pastors including CBOQ representatives	
Nov.7 (Sun)	To announce the nomination list of candidates for ordination to the congregations	
Dec.5 (Sun)	Deadline to accept any written opinion from church members	Note 4
Jan.9 to Jan 16	Congregations vote to accept the candidates for ordination	Note 5
TBD	Ordination Ceremony and Ceremonial Dinner	Note 6

Note 1 – The Church Constitution (5.1.1) permits members with joint signatures to nominate a candidate in writing.

Note 2 – A Deacon Board meeting to finalize the names of all candidates for Ordination.

Note 3 – BTBC will arrange with CBOQ Credential Committee to meet and review BTBC candidates (Sep. 20 to Sep. 30)

Note 4 – The Church Constitution (5.1.1) allows for members opinions, 4 weeks, after the announcement of the nomination list for ordination.

Note 5 - The Church Constitution (5.1.1) outlines a Members vote 8 weeks after the announcement of the list of candidates for ordination to the congregations. Candidates require 75% affirmation by Members (5.1.2) and the Committee agreed voting will be done through paper ballots. With voting no longer aligned to the 2022 Election schedule, the Committee agreed to allow 2 Sundays of voting (Jan 9 & 16) and accept ballots Jan 10-14 during regular office hours.

Note 6 – Given the Pandemic and restrictions for in-person gatherings and restaurant dining, the Deacon Board agreed to schedule the Ordination Ceremony and Ceremonial Dinner at a later time with a preference to host these events in-person after pandemic restrictions are eased.
